The Be the Atom Lesson

Aim: to integrate dramatic art, vocabulary enrichment, chemistry, community,

Materials: A periodic table and room to move

Key Points:

- Review of atomic structure, atomic number, and the connections between them.
- Use the Periodic Table of Elements to choose what element to "be"
- Vocabulary enrichment: protons, neutrons, electrons, orbitals, atomic number, atomic mass
- Divide class in to three equal groups (we use a sock monkey or two to act as an additional player, if needed). 1s are neutrons and 2s are proton partners. They must link arms in the middle and wiggle slightly during performance. 3s are electrons. Fill orbitals as appropriate. Keep students at equal distances across the atom.
- Create shared experience
- Build community through partner coordination and group work
- Perform the element chosen. Electrons run around the atom and protons and neutrons wiggle slightly.
- Rotate positions and perform it three times.

Extension:

- Demonstrate the unsettled nature of ions.
- With multiple rooms, or large numbers, demonstrate molecule formation.
